## COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

March 15, 2022

The event follows current provincial health guidelines and internal stakeholder safety protocols. Protocol will be updated if necessary.

## VACCINE PASSPORTS

Vaccine passports are not required at this time and we will not be checking vaccine passports at the door.

Please respect the other participants and stay home if you are unwell.

## MASKS

Masks are not required at this time but are encouraged.

## SANITIZATION

- **Hand sanitizers** will be available for use at the front door, volunteer gate and the entrance of each indoor area, including the Great Hall, Discovery Room, and Classrooms for Tea Ceremony and Sake Tasting.
- All participants are encouraged and reminded to wash hands and use hand sanitizers regularly.
- Indoor areas will be ventilated where possible

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

- All participants will be encouraged to practice social/physical distancing (also applies to line queues).
- Both indoor and outdoor vendors will be spaced out greater than usual to help facilitate greater traffic flow.
- Indoor areas will require capacity limits where necessary (ie. Discovery Room, Great Hall, Sake and Tea Classrooms).
