The city holds over 40,000 cherry blossom trees, and the blossoming of those endless clouds of flowers are enough reason to celebrate.

Running from Thursday April 4th - Sunday, April 28th, experience Mother Nature's representation of romance, fragility, and growth all rolled into one.

A non-profit festival started in 2005 by Linda Poole, as a way of celebrating the cherry blossom trees, that were gifted to Vancouver from Japan as well as a way of recognizing the beauty around us. It's also a way of honouring the ancient Sakura Festivals of Japan (Hanami), a festival that focuses on the importance of beauty's impermanence - just like the host lifespan of the cherry blossoms.
