

Blossom Barge - Cherry Blossom Festival



Vancouver, Spring time, and cherry blossoms...it is the perfect combo! This combo gets even better on April 16th & 17th when 40 cherry trees, in full bloom, sail through False Creek. In honour of the 10th anniversary of the Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival, the Blossom Barge will be quite the site to see! The barge will depart from Crab Park, sail past Canada Place, Stanley Park, English Bay, Granville Island, Science World and finished at Dock 7 by Granville Island Market.

Some of the best viewing spots will be Canada Place, The Pier, Jack Poole Plaza, and Harbour Green Park.

After the Blossom Barge docks, everyone can enjoy FREE performances on the Blossom Barge stage (noon – 2pm). Performances include Tetsu Taiku & Tzo'kam collaboration, Langley Ukulele Ensemble, Kutapira, Chibi Taiko, and the international yoyo superstar – Harrison Lee.

Also, if you are wondering why buildings (aka Science World, Sails of Lights & Port Metro Vancouver) are glowing pink on April 16th, they too are getting in on the Cherry Blossom celebration.
