From Milan to NYC to Tokyo, cities around the globe are ablaze right now with the fluffy pink blossoms of the cherry tree. And you can get in on the action right here with the Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival's [blossom barge](#). VCBF has created a floating installation of 36 cherry trees to sail through the city's waterways on April 16 and 17. Once the barge moors at Dock 7 each day, just climb aboard for a festival of music and dance, plus an international yo-yo superstar doing his thing. And if you feel like a little jaunt, you can hop on the barge on Sunday at 3 p.m. for its final voyage. Be sure to rock your pink threads so you coordinate with the main attraction!
