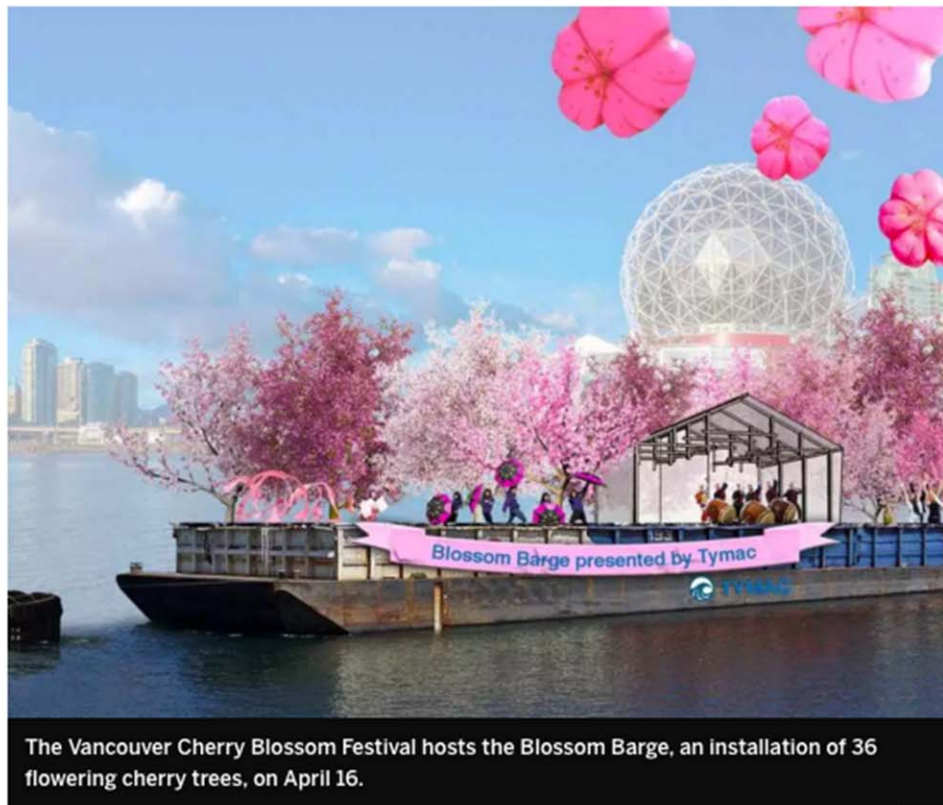

### The Blossom Barge

It's time to celebrate spring. One way to get into the spirit is to check out the floating installation of 36 flowering cherry trees, which parades Vancouver's waterways before mooring at Dock 7 by the Granville Island Public Market. There's also a mini festival of free performances at the market.

8:30 a.m.: The barge departs near Crab Park, parades past Canada Place, Stanley Park, English Bay, Granville Island to Science World, returning to Granville Island Market, where it remains docked until 3 p.m. on April 17.
